CRIME IN WOODFIELD

There have been several reports of things being taken from garages when the garage door has been left open for only a few minutes. Two burglaries have occurred before 7:00 in the morning. One neighbor had his car windows smashed and the garage door opener used to gain entry to their home. Please be an alert neighbor and if you see anything unusual get a vehicle description and tag number and call the police. If a crime has been committed on your property please notify a member of the Board so that we can notify neighbors if these crimes increase.

In Tulsa, the city's "traffic code" (Title 37) prohibits street parking for longer than 24 hours (in Section 519). Complaining neighbors should call the department's non-emergency number, 596-9222. An officer will be sent to make note of the vehicle's location and place a red tag on it. It will be checked again after 24 hours.

UNAUTHORIZED MOTOR VEHICLES
